Revival of Auto Industry

Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES & PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

(a) whether India's auto industry has become one of the largest in the world market;

(b) if so, the details thereof and the contribution of Auto Industries in the country's GDP growth;

(c) whether the Government is aware that the auto industry is severely affected by slowdown during the last three quarters;

(d) if so, whether the auto industry is hit by liquidity crisis and other issues affecting the industry;

(e) if so, the details thereof; and

(f) the corrective measures taken/being taken by the Government to revive the auto industry?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): Yes, the Indian Automobile Industry has evolved over the years and has successfully grown to become a leading automotive industry globally. Auto Industry has become largest in Two wheelers & Three wheelers, 4^{th} largest in Passenger Vehicles, 2^{nd} largest in Heavy Buses and 7^{th} largest in Commercial Vehicles. The automotive industry contributes to approximately 7.1% to India's GDP.

(c): No, the auto Industry's production has increased by 11.34% during April to December 2018-19 as compared to April - December 2017-18.
