Respected Sir,

With reference to D.O. letter No.502/1/2/2014-CA-V dated 5th August, 2014 of Cabinet Secretary, the following significant activities in the Ministry of Heavy Industries (MHI) for the month of August, 2024 are highlighted:

- MHI organized a conference on 'Annual Performance Review' of its operational Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) at Vigyan Bhawan on 30th August, 2024 under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister (HI & Steel), Shri H.D. Kumaraswamy. CMDs and Board of Directors (including Independent Directors) of CPSEs participated in the Conference. During the conference, all CMDs presented operational and financial performance of their CPSE for the financial year 2023-24 and 1st Quarter (i.e. April to June) of 2024-25. CMDs also briefed about significant achievements and key initiatives for efficiency improvements, profitability enhancements, business expansion, modernization and way forward for their CPSE.
- 2. A Post Budget Webinar titled 'e-Mobility, Capital Goods, and Way Forward' bringing together the key stakeholders was chaired by the Hon'ble Minister (HI & Steel) on 22nd August, 2024 with an objective to implement budget announcements in a time bound manner.
- "Har Ghar Tiranga" programme was celebrated successfully by MHI and its Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) / Autonomous Bodies (ABs) during 13th – 15th August, 2024 with great enthusiasm and fervour.
- 4. MHI has notified the Machinery and Electrical Equipment Safety (Omnibus Technical Regulation) Order, 2024 on 28th August, 2024. This Order aims to create a robust technical regulation ecosystem that supports domestic manufacturing and ensure product safety and quality.
- 5. Under PLI-Auto Scheme, Domestic Value Addition (DVA) certificates have been issued to Tata Motors, Mahindra & Mahindra, Ola Electric, and Sona BLW Precision Forgings Ltd. A workshop was also held on 21st August, 2024, with participation from 27 applicant representatives, along with officials from MHI, IFCI Ltd. and Testing agencies (ARAI, ICAT, GARC & NATRAX) to sensitize the PLI beneficiaries.
- 6. Under PLI-ACC Scheme, financial bids for a 10 GWh capacity (end-use agnostic) project were opened on 2nd August, 2024. The case is now under process for placement of Letter of Award (LoA).
- Under the Electric Mobility Promotion Scheme (EMPS) 2024, a cumulative of 36 Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEMs) (151 models) have been registered under electric two-wheeler (e-2W) and three-wheeler (e-3W) segments. Claims for incentives of Rs.132.80 Cr. have been received during the month.

- 8. Issue of GST Concession Certificate in one of the important services provided by MHI under its Citizen's Charter. In August, 2024, a total of 18 GST concession certificates have been issued.
- 9. The Swachhta Pakhwada 2024 was observed successfully by MHI and its CPSEs / Autonomous Bodies from 16th 31st August, 2024.
- 10. BHEL has successfully developed 85 KW Axial Flux Permanent Magnet (PM) based motor for e-mobility and defence applications. This technology offers substantial reduction in size & weight and is ARAI certified for e-bus. Its performance has also been demonstrated to Indian Navy at Naval Dockyard, Vizag.
- 11. BHEL has supplied steam generator for nuclear power plant at Anu Vidyut Pariyojana (GHAVP), Gorakhpur, Haryana. Significantly, this is the 45th steam generator supplied by BHEL, highest by any manufacturer in India.
