Kindly refer to your D.O. letter No. 1/50/3/2024-Cab. dated 24th October, 2024. In so far as the Ministry of Heavy Industries is concerned, the report for the month of August, 2025 for your kind perusal is as follows:

- Policy and other matters pending due to prolonged inter-ministerial consultations:- NIL.

I would like to bring the following to your notice for the month of August, 2025:-

- Hon'ble Prime Minister of India flagged off (virtual mode) MEMU passenger trains on Vaishali – Gaya – Koderma Buddhist Circuit route, East Central Railway and Katosan Road –Sabarmati route, Western Railway aimed to boost tourism, regional development and promote religious access. Notably, the MEMU rakes in these trains are equipped with BHEL's electrical equipments.
- "Har Ghar Tiranga" programme was celebrated successfully by this Ministry and its Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) / Autonomous Bodies (ABs) during 13th to 15th August, 2025 symbolizing a collective commitment to honour the Indian national flag and the spirit of independence. All the activities undertaken by the Ministry, it's CPSEs and ABs have been uploaded on the dedicated portal of Ministry of Culture.
- The Swachhta Pakhwada 2025 was observed successfully by this Ministry and its CPSEs / ABs from 16th to 31st August, 2025. These activities included cleanliness drives, awareness campaigns, e-waste management initiatives and active community participation. The concerted efforts demonstrated the Ministry's continued commitment to fostering a clean and green environment.
- This Ministry has circulated a Concept Note on "Enhancement of Construction and Infrastructure Equipment (CIE) Manufacturing Ecosystem in India" on 28th August, 2025 seeking comments of the concerned stakeholders.
- As per DARPG's Monthly report of July 2025 titled 'Secretariat Reforms', MHI was the 'In-focus' Ministry wherein the achievements of this Ministry were highlighted. Further, this Ministry secured 2nd position for 'Revenue earned from Scrap Disposal' i.e. Rs.4.85 cr across Ministries / Departments.

- f. Under the PM e-Bus Sewa-Payment Security Mechanism (PSM) Scheme, the State Government of Maharashtra has submitted the Direct Debit Mandate (DDM) to the Reserve Bank of India (RBI). Hence, as on 31st August, 2025, total 10 States (Telangana, Karnataka, Rajasthan, Gujarat, Punjab, Meghalaya, Madhya Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh, Uttarakhand, and Maharashtra) have submitted the DDM to RBI.
 - g. Issue of GST Concession Certificate is one of the prominent services provided by MHI under its Citizen's Charter. In August 2025, a total of 406 GST concession certificates were issued to the eligible beneficiaries.
 - h. Inauguration of 170 MW Unit #6 of Punatsangchhu-II HEP was held on 27th August 2025 at the project site in Bhutan. The event was graced by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of Bhutan, the Hon'ble Minister of Power (Bhutan), His Excellency the Ambassador of Bhutan to India, His Excellency the Ambassador of India to Bhutan, along with other senior government officials from both countries.
