Kindly refer to your D.O. Letter No. 1/50/3/2024-Cab. dated 24th October, 2024. In so far as the Ministry of Heavy Industries (MHI) is concerned, the report for the month of January, 2026 for your kind perusal is as follows:

I would like to bring the following to your notice for the month of January, 2026:-

- As per DARPG's monthly report for December 2025 titled 'Secretariat Reforms', MHI secured 3rd position for Revenue Earned from Scrap Disposal i.e. Rs. 9.39 Crs and 5th position in space freed i.e. 44,870 Sq.ft across Ministries/Departments.
- The meetings of the Technical Committee to firm up the Request for Proposal (RFP) on 'Scheme to Promote Manufacturing of Sintered Rare Earth Permanent Magnet' were held on 7th January 2026 and 20th January, 2026. The Techno-Financial Consultant and Legal Consultant have also been appointed by IFCI Ltd. (PMA) on 15th January 2026.
- Under the PM-e Bus Sewa- Payment Security Mechanism (PSM), during the month of January, 2026, Government of NCT of Delhi (GNCTD) got the Direct Debit Mandate (DDM) registered with the Reserve Bank of India (RBI). As of January 2026, a total of 16 States/UTs have submitted the DDM to RBI, having participated in either the PM E-DRIVE Scheme of MHI or the PM-eBus Sewa Scheme of MoHUA. Further, the first tranche of INR 500 crore was also disbursed to CESL during the month to set up the PSM Scheme Fund.”
- Under the PLI-Auto Scheme, Domestic Value Addition certificates were issued to 2 applicants (1 Champion OEM and 1 Component Champion) during the month of January 2026. Domestic Value Addition certificates have been issued to 8 Champion OEMs for 96 products (variants) & 10 Component Champions for 41 products (variants) under the Scheme till 31st January, 2026.
