Kindly refer to your D.O. letter No. 1/50/3/2024-Cab. dated 24th October, 2024. In so far as the Ministry of Heavy Industries is concerned, the report for the month of April, 2026 for your kind perusal is as follows:

- i. Policy and other matters pending due to prolonged inter-ministerial consultations:- NIL.
- ii. Proposals / references pending for long in the Cabinet Secretariat or the Prime Minister's Office:- NIL.
- iii. Particulars of any case in which there has been a departure from Rules of Business:- NIL.
- iv. Any other matter / significant development:-

I would like to bring the following to your notice for the month of April, 2026:-

- BHEL during FY 2025-26 has recorded turnover of Rs. 32,350 Crore, the highest in last decade registering about 18% growth over the previous year. The company now has healthy outstanding order book of Rs. 2.4 lakh Crore as on 31.03.2026, the highest ever for the company.
- As per DARPG's monthly report for March 2026 titled 'Secretariat Reforms', MHI secured 2nd position for revenue earned from scrap disposal i.e., Rs. 11.75 Crs and 3rd position for space freed i.e., 74,138 Sq.ft across Ministries/ Departments.
- As per the latest ranking published by DARPG in its Centralized Public Grievance Redressal and Monitoring System (CPGRAMS) monthly report for the month of March, 2026, MHI secured 2nd position in the Grievance Redressal Assessment & Index (GRAI) within the Group B category i.e., less than 500 Grievances.
- A Stakeholder Consultation on "Indigenous Advanced Chemistry Cell (ACC) Component Manufacturing" was held on 21st April, 2026 with key industry players from the ACC component manufacturing sector and representatives from various Ministries/ Departments to identify key challenges, cost disabilities, technology gaps, and supply chain constraints.
- A meeting of the Committee on "Re-bidding for 20 GWh ACC Capacity under the PLI ACC Scheme" was held on 27th April, 2026 to discuss and finalise the bid documents for the remaining 10 GWh ACC capacity earmarked for Grid Scale Stationary Storage applications, in accordance with the modifications approved by the EGoS in its meeting dated 25.02.2026.

- A Stakeholder Consultation meeting to discuss the financing mechanisms for accelerating the adoption of e-buses and e-trucks in private sector was held on 29th April 2026. The meeting was attended by senior representatives from public and private sector banks, non-banking financial companies (NBFCs), auto sector OEMs, and industry associations.
 - Under the Scheme to Promote Manufacturing of Sintered Rare Earth Permanent Magnet, a pre-bid conference with all prospective bidders was conducted on 7th April, 2026 with the query submission due date set for 22nd April, 2026.
 - Under the PLI-Auto Scheme, 3 Domestic Value Addition Certificates were issued to 3 applicants (2 Champion OEMs and 1 Component Champion) during the month of April 2026. So far, till 30th April, 2026, Domestic Value Addition certificates have been issued to 8 Champion OEMs for 115 products (variants) & 10 Component Champions for 46 products (variants) under the Scheme.
