Kindly refer to your D.O. Letter No. 1/50/3/2024-Cab. dated 24th October, 2024. In so far as the Ministry of Heavy Industries is concerned, the report for the month of June, 2026 for your kind perusal is as follows:

- (i) Policy and other matters pending due to prolonged inter-ministerial consultations:-

- (iv) Any other matter / significant development:-

I would like to bring the following to your notice for the month of June, 2026:-

- Under the PM E-DRIVE Scheme, ₹500 crore has been allocated for the promotion of e-Ambulances. The Notification and Operational Guidelines were issued on 17.06.2026, providing incentives of ₹30,000 per kWh of battery capacity (up to 35% of the ex-factory price) for deployment of approximately 3,811 e-Ambulances across Type B, Type C and Type D categories.
- Hon'ble President of India, Smt. Droupadi Murmu, and Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, remotely laid the foundation stone of Bharat Coal Gasification & Chemicals Limited's (a JV between Coal India Ltd & Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd) coal-to-ammonium nitrate project at Lakhanpur, Jharsuguda district, Odisha, on 20th June 2026.
- Hon'ble Union Minister of Heavy Industries & Steel, Shri H.D. Kumaraswamy, inaugurated BHEL's CSR project at Mandya Institute of Medical Sciences (MIMS), Mandya, Karnataka, on 14th June 2026. The initiative aims to strengthen healthcare infrastructure and improve patient convenience at the government medical institution, which caters to thousands of patients every day.
- The Expenditure Finance Committee (EFC) meeting on the Scheme for "Enhancement of Construction and Infrastructure Equipment (CIE) Manufacturing Ecosystem in India" was held on 30th June, 2026.

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- Under the Scheme to Promote Manufacturing of Sintered Rare Earth Permanent Magnet, the response to pre-bid queries received for the Request for Proposal (RfP) was uploaded on the Central Public Procurement (CPP) Portal on 9th June, 2026. The bid due date is 29th July, 2026.
 - As per the latest ranking published by DARPG in its Centralized Public Grievance Redressal and Monitoring System (CPGRAMS) monthly report for the month of May, 2026, MHI secured 1st position in the Grievance Redressal Assessment & Index (GRAI) within the Group B category, i.e., less than 500 Grievances.
 - Under the PM e-Bus Sewa- Payment Security Mechanism (PSM) Scheme, the State Governments of Bihar and Chhattisgarh submitted their Direct Debit Mandates (DDMs) during June, 2026. Hence, as of June 2026, a total of 21 States/Union Territories have submitted their DDMs to the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), having participated in either the PM E-DRIVE Scheme of MHI or the PM eBus Sewa Scheme of MoHUA.
 - Under the PLI-Auto Scheme, 2 Domestic Value Addition Certificates were issued to 2 applicants (Champion OEMs) during the month of June 2026. So far, till 30th June, 2026, Domestic Value Addition certificates have been issued to 8 Champion OEMs for 121 products (variants) & 10 Component Champions for 47 products (variants) under the Scheme.
 - As a part of the 12th International Yoga Day 2026 themed 'Yoga for Healthy Ageing' celebrations, MHI in association with BHEL, organized a Common Yoga Protocol demonstration at BHEL Township, Noida on 21st June, 2026. I alongwith senior officers / officials of MHI and senior management of all CPSEs of MHI in Delhi also participated in the event.
