Respected Sir,

Kindly refer to your D.O. Letter No. 1/50/3/2024-Cab. dated 24th October, 2024. In so far as the Ministry of Heavy Industries is concerned, the report for the month of July, 2026 for your kind perusal is as follows:

- (i) Policy and other matters pending due to prolonged inter-ministerial consultations:- NIL
- (ii) Proposals / references pending for long in the Cabinet Secretariat or the Prime Minister's Office:- NIL.
- (iii) Particulars of any case in which there has been a departure from Rules of Business:- NIL.
- (iv) Any other matter / significant development:-

I would like to bring the following to your notice for the month of July, 2026:-

- BHEL recorded Revenue from Operations of Rs. 7,698 Crore in Q1 FY 2026-27, registering 40% year-on-year growth and its strongest first-quarter revenue performance since FY 2012-2013. EBITDA improved to Rs.735 Crore, while Profit Before Tax (PBT) and Profit After Tax (PAT) turned positive at Rs. 513 Crore and Rs.382 Crore respectively, marking a return to first-quarter profitability after seven years.
- The Ministry issued the Request for Proposal (RfP) on 15th July, 2026 through the Central Public Procurement (CPP) Portal, inviting global competitive bids for the allocation of the balance 10 GWh ACC manufacturing capacity, earmarked for Grid Scale Stationary Storage applications, under the PLI ACC Scheme. Further, the Ministry conducted a Pre-Bid Conference on 29th July, 2026. The conference was attended by prospective bidders, representatives from industry, NITI Aayog, MNRE, M/o Power, and other stakeholders.
- Under the PLI Auto Scheme, first incentive claim of 787.79 crores for FY 2026-27 has been disbursed.
- Under the PLI-Auto Scheme, 6 Domestic Value Addition Certificates were issued to 2 applicants (Champion OEMs) during the month of July 2026. So far, till 31st July, 2026, Domestic Value Addition certificates have been issued to 8 Champion OEMs for 127 products (variants) & 10 Component Champions for 47 products (variants) under the Scheme.
- Under the PM e-Bus Sewa- Payment Security Mechanism (PSM) Scheme, the 5th Steering Committee approved an alternate mechanism proposed by the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) for four Union Territories in lieu of Direct Debit Mandate (DDM) registration with the RBI. Under the approved mechanism, MHA shall replenish the PSM Fund, along with applicable interest, in the event of any default by these UTs. Consequently, in the month of July 2026, 26 of the 27 participating States/UTs have completed the DDM requirement under the scheme.

- TB Mukht Bharat Abhiyaan – 100 Days Campaign was conducted from 24th March 2026 to 2nd July 2026. Under this initiative, CPSEs and Autonomous Bodies (ABs) under the Ministry organized a range of activities aimed at tuberculosis awareness, prevention, and support. These activities included the administration of the Nikshay Shapath (pledge ceremony) for TB elimination, TB screening drives, clinical examination and health camps, as well as Information, Education and Communication (IEC) and awareness programmes. Collectively, these efforts benefited more than 5,000 individuals, significantly contributing towards the goal of TB elimination.
- As per the latest ranking published by DARPG in its Centralized Public Grievance Redressal and Monitoring System (CPGRAMS) monthly report for the month of June, 2026, MHI secured 6th position in the Grievance Redressal Assessment & Index (GRAI) within the Group B category, i.e., less than 500 Grievances.
- BHEL bagged largest-ever single export order valuing Rs.2,283 crore for design, manufacture, supply, and supervision of erection & commissioning of 8 Gas Turbine Generator (GTG) Packages for Petroleum Refinery and Polypropylene Plant at Dangote Industries Free Zone, Nigeria.
